Our low-carbon alternatives for electricity, natural gas, and transportation fuel help your organization reduce its environmental impact and take meaningful action against climate change. How it works

Your company chooses green energy through Bullfrog Power. When you bullfrogpower your facilities, you're changing the way energy is generated on your behalf. We inject the same amount of renewable energy onto the system that your bullfrogpowered facilities, equipment, vehicles, or entire company uses. This displaces conventional energy sources such as fossil fuels, nuclear, and large-scale hydro.

By choosing green energy, you're reducing energy-related emissions and helping transition Canada's grid to renewable, pollution-free energy.

The bullfrogpowered community also provides critical funding to small-scale, community-based green energy and cleantech projects. Here are a few examples of the more than 160 projects we've supported from coast to coast:

The Marine Mammal Rescue Centre, Vancouver, BC

The Marine Mammal Rescue Centre sayes more than 150 mammals and releases them back into the wild every year. Bullfrog Power funded 50% of a 4.8 kW solar project on the Rescue Centre's roof, allowing the Centre to redirect funds toward its rehabilitation efforts



Lutsel K'e Dene First Nation, Lutselk'e, NWT

The Lutsel K'e Dene First Nation is a remote community living on the Great Slave Lake in the Northwest Territories, With the launch of its 35 kW solar protect. built with support from the Bullfrog community, they became the first independent power producer in Canada's northern territories.



Hope Blooms Greenhouse Solar Project, Halifax, NS

For young people in Halifax, a community greenhouse run by non-profit Hope Blooms is an opportunity for education, empowerment- and a brighter future. With support from Bullfrog customers, Hope Blooms installed a solar array on the greenhouse and two solar awnings providing clear


